



** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **

Start by marking and cutting the Color 1.2-1/2" x 5" strip into two 2-1/2" squares. Mark and cut the Color 1.2-1/2" x 9" strip into two 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. Mark and cut the Color 1.2-1/2" x 13" strip into two 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles...

Now mark and cut the Color 2 2-1/2" x 20" strip into eight 2-1/2" squares...

Then mark and cut the Color 4 2-1/2" x 15" strip into six 2-1/2" squares. Mark and cut the Color 4 5" x 18" strip into eight 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. Mark and cut the Color 4 2-1/2" x 13" strip into two 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles...

1 Floral – (2) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" Sqs (all floral surrounds yellow Sq)

(2) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Rectangles

(2) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Rectangles


2 Green – (8) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" Sqs (2 at each corner)

3 Yellow – (1) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" Sq (Center Square)

4 White- (6) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" Sqs (background)

(8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Rectangles

(2) 2-1/2 x 6-1/2" Rectangles



Now, using all scant 1/4" seams, sew the seven horizontal rows shown at left. Press all seams towards the darker fabric. Sew the rows together, and you are done! Good Job!!

Color 1 Color 1 needs: one 2-1/2" x 5" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 9" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 13" strip

Color 2 <u>Color 2 needs</u>: one 2-1/2" x 20" strip

Color 3 needs: one 2-1/2" square

Color 4 Color 4 needs: one 2-1/2" x 15" strip AND one 5" x 18" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 13" strip

Color 1 = any small floral print; Color 2 = any small green print; Color 3 = yellow; Color 4 = white Happy quilting!!
