

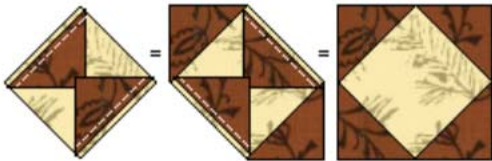
Goose Creek

This makes a 12" block, and is another GREAT one for beginners...or anyone who wants to make a quilt in a hurry! :o)



** Supplies List **

Each block needs ten "dark" 2-1/2" squares AND eight "light" 2-1/2" squares AND two 4-3/4" "light" squares AND eight "dark" half square triangles, cut from four 3-7/8" squares (or paper pieced)



Cut 2 triangles from 3-7/8" squares of "dark/medium dark" mottled fabric.

The center square is 4-3/4" "light" square. Press seams towards outer triangles. This should measure 6-1/2". Trim back if needed.



Now just piece the block! Make rows, then sew the rows together, again using scant 1/4" seams. Press row seams in alternating directions. All Done!!

Please note: We would like the dark or medium dark fabric to be in mottled tones (not bright). I have some old Thimbleberries fabric that is perfect. See you next month.
