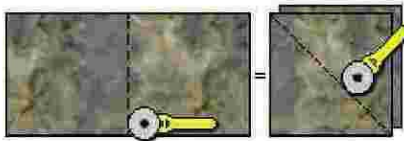


Supply list: (Choose fall colors browns, burgundy, oranges, greens Etc) and cream. Each block should be of the same color with medium and a dark fabrics of the same color, except the background which is cream or off-white.

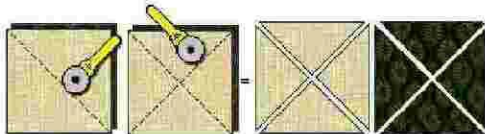
Color 3 Cream . Cut four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips and one 5 1/4" square.

Color 1 Medium color . Cut two 4 7/8" squares. Then cut diagonally once. (see diagram below)

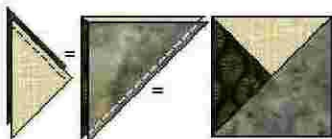


Color 2 Dark color. Cut one 5 1/4" square and one 2 1/2 x 2 1/2" square.

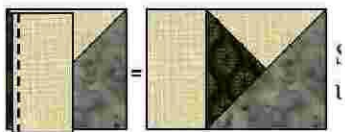
Take the cream and the Dark 5 1/4" squares, place them right sides together and cut diagonally. Without moving them cut on the other diagonal as well, to get four quarter triangles of each.



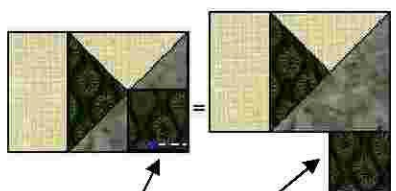
Now sew pairs of dark and cream quarter square triangles together at a scant 1/4" seam. (As in the diagram.) Press towards the darker side. To each of these sew a medium half triangle. Press seams towards 1/2" triangle. Trim back to 4 1/2" squares as needed.



Sew cream rectangle to the left side (dark color side) to each of the previously made units, pressing seams towards the darker side.

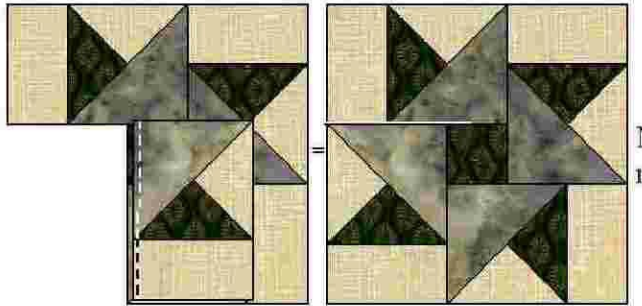
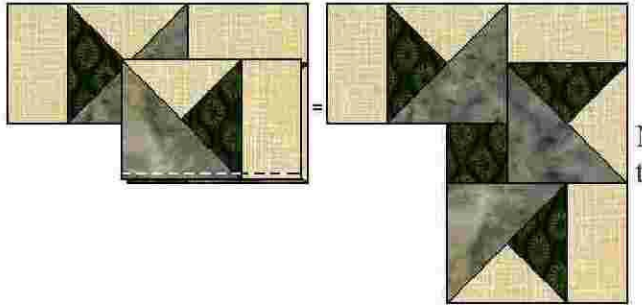
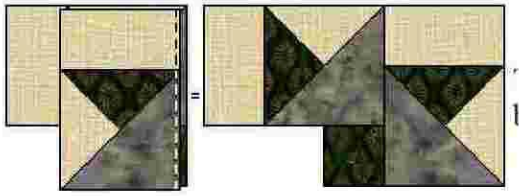


Next line up the Color 2 Dark 2 1/2" square with the bottom right edge of the pieced units. Stitch in a scant 1/4" seam from the outer block edge in as far as half way across the square. Backstitch and snip threads.

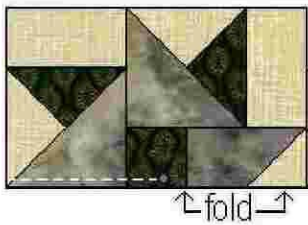


STITCH HALFWAY ACROSS
THE DARK SQUARE

Continue to sew on the next unit clockwise around the block pressing towards the newly added unit.



Now fold the block right sides together, align the unsewn part of the last seam. Stitch to just where you stopped stitching and you are done.



Block should be 10-1/2 inches square unfinished.
