-  Color 1 Color 1 needs: one 2-1/2" x 20" strip
-  Color 2 Color 2 needs: one 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" strip AND one 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" st
-  Color 3 Color 3 needs: one 2-1/2" x 10" strip AND one 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strip
-  Color 4 Color 4 needs: one 2-7/8" x 23" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 26" strip

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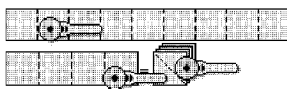

To the Patterns or The Quilter's Cache

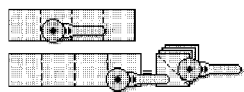
** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



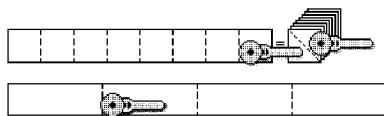
Start by cutting the Color 1 2-1/2" x 20" strip into eight 2-1/2" squares...



Next cut the Color 2 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" strip into nine 2-1/2" squares. Cut the Color 2 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strip into four 2-7/8" squares. Stack those 2-7/8" squares and cut them in half once on the diagonal to make eight half square triangles...



Now cut the Color 3 2-1/2" x 10" strip into four 2-1/2" squares. Cut the Color 3 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strip into four 2-7/8" squares. Stack those 2-7/8" squares and cut them in half once on the diagonal to make eight half square triangles...



Then cut the Color 4 2-7/8" x 23" strip into eight 2-7/8" squares. Stack those and cut once on the diagonal to make sixteen half square triangles. Cut the Color 4 2-1/2" x 26" strip into four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles...



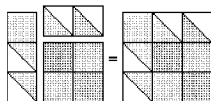
Use Color 1 and Color 2 2-1/2" squares to sew four of the Four Patch units shown at left. Use a scant 1/4" seam allowance from now on! Press the seams to the darker sides. Each Four Patch should measure 4-1/2"...



Next, use Color 3 and Color 4 half square triangles to make eight of the Half Square units shown at left. Again, 1/4" seam allowances should be used, and press seams to the darker sides. These should each measure 2-1/2". Trim if needed. Now repeat this with Color 2 and Color 4 half square triangles to make eight Half Squares in that color arrangement...

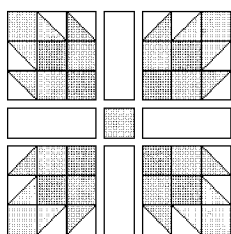


Then sew four of each of the two units shown at left. The top unit uses one Color 2/Color 4 Half Square, one Color 3/Color 4 Half Square and a Color 3 square. These should measure 2-1/2" x 6-1/2"...



The second unit uses one Color 3/Color 4 Half Square, and one Color 2/Color 4 Half Square. These should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"...

To make the Corner units sew one of the shorter units we just made to the top of each Four Patch unit, pressing seam towards the Four Patch. Add a longer unit to the left side of those Four Patch units, pressing seam towards the longer strips. These units should now measure 6-1/2" square...



Now lay out all units as shown at left. Sew three horizontal rows, pressing seams in alternating directions by row. Join the rows to complete your block!

COLOR 1 - PINK OR YELLOW

COLOR 2 - PINK OR YELLOW OF ANOTHER SHADE

COLOR 3 - PALE GREEN

COLOR 4 - WHITE TONE-ON-TONE
