BLOCK OF THE MONTH PATTERN FOR SEPTEMBER 21, 2010

DIRECTIONS:

WHITE ON WHITE FABRIC-

CUT TWO STRIPS 2-1/2" X 22"

FROM EACH STRIP CUT TWO 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" AND 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" RECTANGLES.

FOUR DIFFERENT BRIGHT COLORS-

CUT ONE 4-1/2" X 4-1/2" SQUARE FROM EACH BRIGHT COLOR.
AND CUT TWO 2-1/2" X 2-1/2" SQUARES FROM EACH BRIGHT COLOR.


YOU WILL NOW HAVE FOUR - 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" WHITE ON WHITE RECTANGLES

FOUR – 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" WHITE ON WHITE RECTANGLES FOUR – 4-1/2" SQUARES OF EACH BRIGHT COLOR EIGHT 2-1/2" SQUARES, TWO OF EACH BRIGHT COLOR

ASSEMBLY:

1. DRAW A DIAGONAL LINE ON THE WRONG SIDE OF EACH OF THE 2-1/2" BRIGHT SQUARES. PLACE ONE COLORED SQUARE ON ONE END OF THE 2-1/2" X 4-1/2" WHITE RECTANGLE, ORIENTATING THE DIAGONAL LINE AS SHOWN IN DIAGRAM 1, STITCH ON THE DRAWN LINE. TRIM SEAM ALLOWANCE TO 1/4", PRESS SEAM TOWARDS THE TRIANGLE; REPEAT WITH A MATCHING COLOR SQUARE ON THE 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" WHITE RECTANGLE, ORIENTATING THE DIAGONAL LINE IN THE **OPPOSITE DIRECTION** AS SHOWN IN DIAGRAM 2.









2, FOLLOWING DIAGRAM 3, SEW THE SHORTER WHITE UNIT ASSEMBLED IN STEP ONE TO ONE SIDE OF THE MATCHING COLORED 4-1/2" SQUARE. PRESS SEAM TOWARD SQUARE. STITCH THE LONGER WHITE UNIT TO THE OTHER SIDE OF THE SECTION AS SHOWN BELOW IN DIAGRAM 3. PRESS THE SEAM AWAY FROM THE SQUARE.







3. REPEAT ABOVE STEPS FOR THE OTHER 3 COLORED FABRICS. LAY OUT THE FOUR COLOR SECTIONS SO THAT TWO POINT OUTWARD, AND TWO POINT INWARD AS SHOWN BELOW. ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK.
